Statutory Curriculum Overview 2017-2018 Year 5

English

Our Spring term text is 'A Girl of Ink and Stars' by Kiran Millwood Hargrave, with an end of term focus of writing our own Myth or Legend.

We will be continuing to learn the Year 5 spelling rules and plugging gaps from previous years, and we will be applying our new grammar skills in a variety of writing genres.

Mathematics

Multiplication and division - multiply and divide numbers mentally. Multiply up to 4 digits by 2 digits and divide 4 digits by 1 digit including dividing with remainders.

Fractions - Compare and order fractions, identify, name and write equivalent fractions, understand and identify improper fractions, add, subtract and multiply a variety of fractions.

Decimals and percentages - read, write, order and compare numbers with up to three decimal places, recognise and use thousandths and relate them to tenths, hundredths and decimal equivalents.
